

## 2016 Disclosure Calendar Appellate Court Judicial Candidates

<b>Please Note:</b>	This calendar does not apply to appellate court candidates who will not appear on the ballot in 2016.
February 1	<b>2015 Year-end Report of Receipts and Expenditures due.</b> Period covered: 1/1 through 12/31/2015.
February 2	\$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the Year-end Report of Receipts and Expenditures.
March 31	Last day of transactions included in the First Report of Receipts and Expenditures.
April 14	<b>First Report of Receipts and Expenditures due.</b> Period covered: 1/1 through 3/31/2016.
April 15	\$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the First Report of Receipts and Expenditures.
May 17	Candidate filing period opens to run for office.
May 31	Last day for candidates to file to run for office.
May 31	Last day of transactions included in the Second Report of Receipts and Expenditures.
June 14	<b>Second Report of Receipts and Expenditures due.</b> Period covered: 1/1 through 5/31/2016.
June 15	\$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the Second Report of Receipts and Expenditures.
July 18	Last day of transactions included in the Third Report of Receipts and Expenditures.
July 19 through August 8	<b>24 Hour Reporting of Large Contributions – Pre-Primary Election</b> Contributions and loans from any one source totaling more than \$2,000 for appellate court candidates must be reported to the Board in person by the end of the next business day after receipt or by electronic means within 24 hours after receipt and also on subsequent Reports of Receipts and Expenditures for the year. Failure to file the notice on time will result in a \$50 per day late filing fee. Note: Candidates who are unopposed at the primary election do not need to report large contributions during this period.
July 25	<b>Third Report of Receipts and Expenditures due.</b> Period covered: 1/1 through 7/18/2016.
July 26	\$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the Third Report of Receipts and Expenditures.
August 9	PRIMARY ELECTION
September 20	Last day of transactions included in the Fourth Report of Receipts and Expenditures.
September 27	<b>Fourth Report of Receipts and Expenditures due.</b> Period covered: 1/1 through 9/20/2016.
September 28	\$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the Fourth Report of Receipts and Expenditures.
October 24	Last day of transactions included in the Fifth Report of Receipts and Expenditures.

October 25 through November 7 **24 Hour Reporting of Large Contributions – Pre-General Election**  
Contributions and loans from any one source totaling more than \$2,000 for appellate court candidates must be reported to the Board in person by the end of the next business day after receipt or by electronic means within 24 hours after receipt and also on subsequent Reports of Receipts and Expenditures for the year. Failure to file the notice on time will result in a \$50 per day late filing fee. Note: Candidates who lost the primary election do not need to report large contributions during this period.

October 31 **Fifth Report of Receipts and Expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1 through 10/24/2016.

November 1 \$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the Fifth Report of Receipts and Expenditures.

November 8 GENERAL ELECTION

January 31 **2016 Year-end Report of Receipts and Expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2016 through 12/31/2016.

February 1 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the Year-end Report of Receipts and Expenditures.
