ETHICAL PRACTICES BOARD ISSUES REPORT  
ON LOBBYING DISBURSEMENTS FOR 1983

Lobbying disbursements during 1983, disclosed by 1,052 lobbyists for 821 associations and individuals totaled \$1,048,121, according to reports filed with the Ethical Practices Board.

Lobbyists filed a total of 6,383 quarterly reports for 1983 and disclosed that 464 associations and individuals reported disbursements for lobbying purposes (57% of the associations and individuals for whom lobbyists are registered).

Included in the Board's summary are lobbyists representing 194 associations and individuals who reported lobbying disbursements of \$663,073 (63% of total lobbying disbursements); lobbying subjects in this group include Business Related Associations, Businesses, Chamber of Commerce, Petroleum and Natural Gas, Transportation, and Public Utilities.

A total of 56 citizen groups reported lobbying disbursements of \$65,123 (6% of total lobbying disbursements in 1983).

Other 1983 lobbying disbursements of \$319,925 (31% of total disbursements) are reported by lobbyists for 189 associations and individuals whose lobbying subjects include Health, Education, Agriculture/Environment, Banks, Insurance, Government, Labor/Employee Relations, and Legal.

In 1982 total disbursements were \$732,577, reported by lobbyists for 387 associations and individuals (52% of the 750 associations and individuals represented by lobbyists); in 1981, lobbyists for 423 associations and individuals reported

total disbursements of \$921,443 for lobbying purposes (55% of the 766 associations and individuals represented by lobbyists).

Lobbying disbursements for the ten associations reporting the highest expenditures in 1983 totaled \$463,615 (44% of lobbying disbursements in 1983).

Minnesota's Ethics in Government Act (Minn. Stat. Chapter 10A) requires lobbyists to report to the Ethical Practices Board disbursements for lobbying purposes including a gift, loan, honorarium, entertainment, food or beverage, travel and lodging of \$20 or more to a public official; preparing and distributing lobbying materials; media advertising, telephone, telegraph, and postage; fees and allowances; entertainment, food and beverage, travel and lodging. Lobbyists are not required to disclose their salaries or their political contributions. All lobbyist reports are available for public inspection at the Board office.

The Board has prepared a summary of lobbying disbursements during 1983. Included are listings of individuals or associations that contributed over \$500 to associations for lobbying purposes and public officials who received gifts or other benefits of \$20 or more disclosed in reports filed by lobbyists in 1983. A copy of the summary is available for viewing at the Board office, 41 State Office Building, St Paul, MN.

**Who is a Lobbyist?**

- Any individual who is engaged for pay or other consideration or authorized by another individual or association to spend money and who spends more than five hours in any month or more than \$250 in any year (not including travel expenses and membership dues) for the purpose of attempting to influence legislative or administrative action by communicating with or urging others to communicate with public officials.
- Any individual who spends more than \$250 in any year (not including travel expenses and membership dues) for the purpose of attempting to influence legislative or administrative action by communicating with or urging others to communicate with public officials.
- Any individual who merely communicates with a public official to obtain information or request an interpretation of a law, rule or agency action is not a "lobbyist."

**What is Lobbying?**

Lobbying is defined as attempting to influence legislative or administrative action by communicating with public officials or urging others to communicate with public officials.

- "Administrative action" means an action by any official, board, commission or agency of the executive branch (does not include metropolitan agencies) to adopt, amend, or repeal a rule. "Administrative action" does not include the application or administration of an adopted rule, except in cases of rate setting, power plant siting, and granting of certificates of need under Minnesota Statutes Chapter 116J.
- "Legislative action" means any action or nonaction with regard to any bill, resolution, amendment, nomination, appointment, report, or any other matter which may be the subject of action by either house of the legislature, committee, subcommittee, or commission of the legislature. "Legislative action" also means an attempt to influence a gubernatorial approval or veto of any bill, or an attempt to influence the governor or any public official about development of a proposal for introduction in the legislature.

**What must Lobbyists report?**

Each year lobbyists are required to file quarterly reports with the Ethical Practices Board. During calendar year 1983, 1,052 lobbyists filed approximately 6,383 reports for 821 associations or individuals, disclosing expenditures totalling \$1,048,121.

**ORIGINAL SOURCE OF FUNDS** (for lobbying purposes)

Lobbyists must disclose the names of individuals or associations that contribute to the lobbyist or the association the lobbyist represents over \$500 in a calendar year for lobbying purposes.

#### ABOUT LOBBYIST DISCLOSURE

A state system of permanent registration of lobbyists and reporting of lobbying disbursements, established by the legislature in 1974, under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 10A.

- . To enable public officials and the public to know who is being represented and by whom; and
- . How much is being spent to influence legislative and administrative actions of public officials.
- . An individual who merely communicates with a public official to obtain information or request an interpretation of a law, rule, or agency action is not a "lobbyist".
- . All lobbyist registrations and reports filed with the Ethical Practices Board are available in the Board office, within 48 hours of receipt, for public viewing and photocopying at cost.

**DISBURSEMENTS** (reporting categories)

**Preparing and distributing lobbying materials**

The cost of research and writing of reports from which data is subsequently used for lobbying materials is not reportable.

The cost of preparation, publication, and distribution of newsletters or other publications includes pro-rata office expenses and compensation paid to an employee. However, only the cost of that portion of the newsletter or publication which is lobbying material need be reported.

**Media advertising**

Only the cost of media including but not limited to billboards, newspapers, radio, and television time which advocate a particular position is reportable.

**Telegraph and telephone**

**Postage**

**Fees, salaries, and allowances**

Includes consultant fees for lobbying purposes as well as expenses incurred in providing those services. Includes compensation for clerical expense incurred for providing lobbying materials or organizing communication with public officials or in urging others to communicate with public officials.

This category does not include compensation paid to a lobbyist for services as a lobbyist on behalf of the employer.

**Entertainment**

Includes cost of entertainment provided for a lobbying purpose to public officials as well as the cost of entertainment for the lobbyist, the employer, or employee of the lobbyist when in the company of the public official for whom the lobbyist has paid the cost of the entertainment.

**Food and beverage, travel, and lodging**


Includes the cost of food, beverages, travel, and lodging provided by a lobbyist, the employer, or employee of a lobbyist at meetings, banquets, or similar functions for a lobbying purpose.

Includes the costs of food, beverages, travel and lodging provided by a lobbyist, the employer, or employee of a lobbyist at meetings or conferences for the purpose of urging other to communicate with public officials.

Includes the cost of food, beverages, travel, and lodging for paid expert witness if not registered as a lobbyist.

Includes the cost of travel and lodging of a lobbyist for the purpose of lobbying except those incurred to enable the lobbyist to attend a meeting of or to appear before a committee of the legislature, a state board, commission, or agency.


**TOTAL DISBURSEMENTS IN 1983 - \$1,048,121**

##### Purpose

- . To maintain confidence in the integrity of government through public disclosure and public financing of candidates through administration of the Ethics in Government Act, Minn. Stat. Ch. 10A.

##### Members

- . Six member citizen body;
- . Appointed by the governor; confirmed by a 3/5th vote of both houses of the legislature;
- . One former legislator of each major party;
- . Two individuals who have not been a public official nor a political party officer in the last three years;
- . No more than three members of the same political party.
